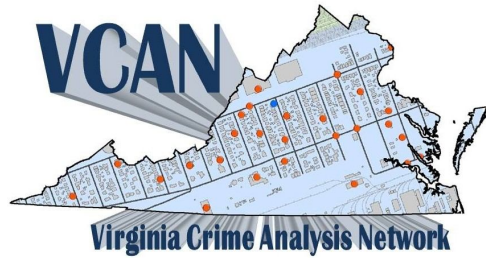

It's that time of year to renew (or join) the Virginia Crime Analysis Network! The deadline to renew your membership for VCAN's upcoming fiscal year is January 31, 2012. Please **make checks payable to "VIRGINIA CRIME ANALYSIS NETWORK"** as there are a number of other associations with the acronym V.C.A.N. that bank with our financial institution and other regional banks.

Below, please see the 2012 membership levels and associated fees:

- **Full VCAN & IACA Membership - \$50**
This level of membership is granted to professionals of law enforcement within the Commonwealth of Virginia. In addition to membership in VCAN, this level will provide membership in the International Association of Crime Analysts (IACA) with a savings of \$5 off the individual IACA member fee. Members at this level will have voting authority in VCAN and IACA and full access to IACA's members only section of their website.
- **Academic Membership - \$50**
This will be given to students and academic professionals who are involved with the criminal justice community within the Commonwealth of Virginia. Such members will not have voting authority.
- **Corporate Membership - \$150**
This level of membership is granted to private sector professionals who maintain an investigative or support role in the law enforcement community within the Commonwealth of Virginia. Such members will not have voting authority.
- **Agency Membership – (4-7 individuals \$100, 8-11 \$200 and 12 or more \$300)**
This will be given to agencies with more than four individuals from the same law enforcement agency within the Commonwealth of Virginia. Such members will only be allowed one vote from their agency. (If selecting Agency Membership, please provide a list of ALL persons who will be covered under the membership, as well as their contact information)

Please remember that dues for FY 2012 should be submitted no later than January 31, 2011!
